We know people will be anxious to get their booster jab following the announcement by the Prime Minister at 8pm on Sunday 12th December 2021. Unfortunately, we haven't had any advance notice of the information before the announcement and therefore we are now trying to organise the logistics relating to the supply of the vaccines to the surgery. Once we have information on the supply we shall then be able to arrange booster clinics.

In the meantime please don't ring reception to try and book a jab. When we are able to arrange the booster clinics we will send invites to patients, please ensure we have your up to date mobile phone number as we will be initially texting patients with an appointment invite.
